How to Score Points For the Class

Dear Class,

Your job is to learn Spanish and use it. Depending on how you do, you will get a title. Not a Mr. or Mrs. or Dr. or Your Majesty, but you will get a title. It's like getting a grade. Your title will be Participant, Professional or World Citizen. It takes points to do this.

Your class gets 100 points every time it spends about 10 minutes with one of our video lessons or our Spanish Fluency Builder. You can count a lesson more than once.

Your class gets 10 points every time one of you speaks Spanish. You will learn things in the video lessons and Fluency Builder that you will want to try saying when you're ready. Most kids your age want to start speaking a new language right away. But you don't have to, and you don't have to say a lot. Just help out by saying some things when you're ready. Your class will get 200 points a day when the class says 20 things in Spanish. It will get 300 points for saying 30 things, and 400 points for saying 40 things in Spanish.

At the end of each day, your class writes its score in a chart. In a week's time, you might earn hundreds of points...maybe 400 or 500 or a thousand. Go for it!
